## Double Header Games : League Instructions

Where a large amount of games are postponed in any division "double headers" may be brought in to ease the fixture congestion. These will be updated on the Full Time System with the two fixtures between Clubs being shown with the same date.

## Recording Results

Two separate matches shall be played and the results recorded separately

A Separate match form should be completed for both games

Full Results and Statistics should be submitted and entered on to the Full Time system for two separate fixtures

## Match Timing guide

Two separate matches shall be played and the results recorded separately The games in total should not exceed 100 mins (ie: both games combined).

U12s, U13s \& U14s - 20 minutes each way, per game

U15s, U16s \& U18s - 25 minutes each way, per game

All timings should be agreed prior to the match with both teams \& the referee

## Match Costs

Pitch costs - where a Club has incurred additional costs hosting a double header these additional costs should be shared between both Clubs. The host Club must notify the away team of these costs in advance of the fixture.

The Home club must show evidence of any additional cost incurred compared to hosting a normal home fixture

Referee fees - where a club pay their match officials, the cost of a Referee for a double Header will be shared between the two Clubs. The host Club must notify the away team of these costs in advance of the fixture.
